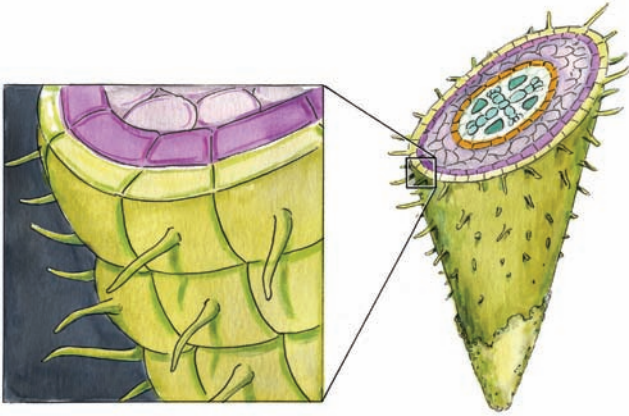


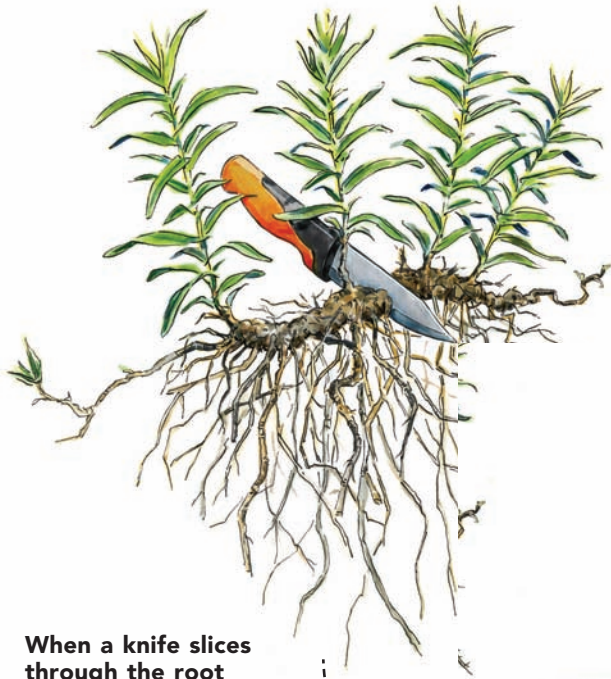
# • A CLOSER LOOK AT DIVISION •



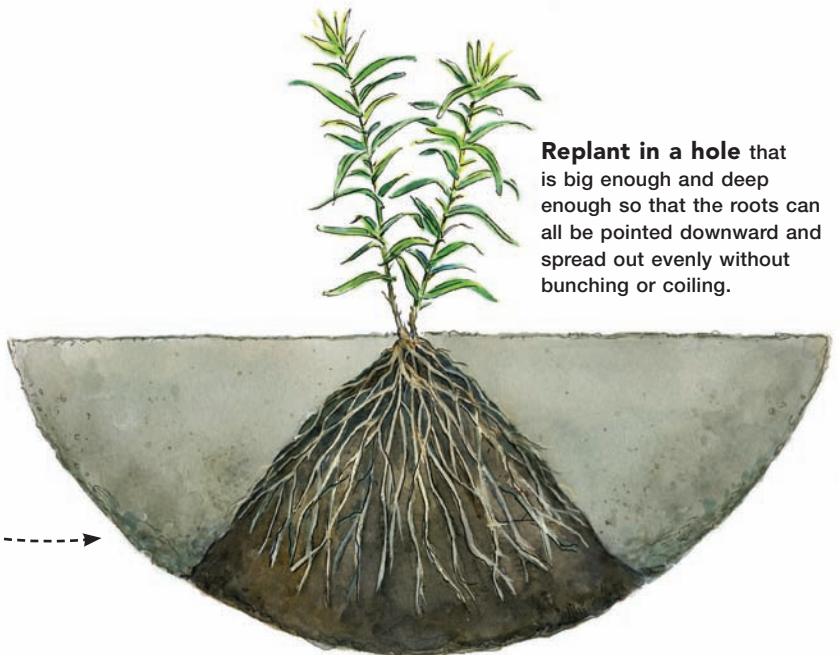
**Root hairs are microscopic** and are located just above the root tip. Each hair absorbs water into the core of the root.



**After being dug out of the ground,** a plant loses most, if not all, of its invaluable root hairs.



**When a knife slices through the root system,** most plants send out a wound signal to help protect the plant from potential infection and disease.



**Replant in a hole** that is big enough and deep enough so that the roots can all be pointed downward and spread out evenly without bunching or coiling.
